- A workshop on GST filing was conducted on July 4, 2023. Dhanalakshmi, senior accountant at Dynamic Kitchen Equipment, was the resource person for the workshop. The workshop clarified how to register a GST number for commercial use. It explored several parts of the Goods and Services Tax (GST), its sophisticated structure, and the ramifications for businesses.
- A seminar on career opportunities in banking and the financial market was conducted on July 7, 2023. Jeyaprakash Maria Michael, Director, MCUBE Academy, was the resource person. The resource person explained the fee schedule and the comprehensive course plan by sharing his experience in the capital market.
